



2011 BOARD AND TRAINING FEES

Board: \$610 / Horse – Payable to LAEC.

Stalls are 12 X 12, automatic fly spray, automatic water. Horses are bedded on shavings and stalls are cleaned 2x per day. Includes feeding of hay cubes 2x daily.

- Mandatory Trainer Fee \$40. Per LAEC – payable to MMT.

Extra Feed – Minimum \$200 Purchase / Horse – Payable to MMT.

We design a specialized feed program that is suitable for each individual horse and their training program, using a variety of top quality grains. Alfalfa and Timothy Hay can be fed 2x daily for extra fee payable to MMT. We also offer many extra supplements on an individual basis. Any extra supplements that may be necessary for your horse's health and performance will be either directly invoiced from the vendor or billed separately by MMT.

Training Program “1A” - \$1200.00 / Horse

Includes 5-6 Services (riders, private lessons, treadmill, walker, or lunging) per week, complete horse management of vets, farriers, therapists, feed program and administrative services such as horse show entries and close outs. This program is designed to offer a discount for those clients who compete regularly at horse shows. Horse show day fee are at a reduced rate. NO DAY FEES WILL BE CHARGED AT SHOWS FOR CLIENTS IN PROGRAM “A.”

Training Program “1B” - \$800 / Horse

Includes 4-5 services (rides, private lessons, treadmill, walker or lunging) per week, complete horse management of vets, farriers, therapists, feed program and administrative services such as horse show entries and close outs. Horse show day fees are charged at regular rate.

Horse “Care” Program - \$400 / Horse

This service is provided seven days a week. Includes all grooming, care, and maintenance of horses and equipment. (i.e., tack-up & un-tack for trainer and/or rider, tack cleaning, laundry service, turn out, hand walking, treadmill, walker, blanketing, icing, wrapping, lunging, feeding grain and supplements am/pm, administering necessary medications & therapy, vet assistance, clipping, (with the exception of body clipping) mane pulling, etc. Our desire is to provide the highest quality of care for every horse. This service is **required** with training program “A” or “B”.

Layup and Rehabilitation Program - \$650 / Horse.

This service is provided 7 days a week and includes all necessary turn out, hand walking, treadmill, grooming, care and management for the horse that is laid up and needs special care/therapy.

Supplies - \$50.00 / Horse

Includes all supplies necessary for Horse Care at home. (i.e., brushes towels, leg wraps, polo's, bell boots, work pads, shampoo, hoof oil, tape, laundry soap, fly spray, show sheen, alcohol, ointments, poultice, hoof pack, ice boots, vacuums, ear plugs, carrots, hay nets, tubs, spray bottles, arnica, hoof picks, mane combs, turn out blankets, turn out boots, fly masks, feed buckets, water buckets, stall gates, brooms, shovels, picks, wheel barrows, muck skips, clippers, blades, rubber mats, cross ties, lunge lines, lunge whips, surcingles, biting rigs, extra bits etc. Supplies, tools, labor expense for all barn, ring, jump, and equipment repair and maintenance, office supplies, etc.

All Invoiced Are Due By The Stated Date.

Past Due Invoices Are Subject To A \$50.00 Late Fee Per Invoice.

Two-week written notice of departure date is required to receive prorated fees; otherwise you are responsible for the entire month. All late arrivals will be proated accordingly. Any credits due will be applied to the following month. All fees due to MMT must be paid in full before releasing the horse.

All signed package contracts will expire at the end of the year dated and will be subject to change before renewal. Prices are subject to change after 30 days with a written notice.

All program services will void after the month is over, therefore all paid services must be used by the end of the month. They will NOT carry over to the next month.
